### 10 Middle school tips for success

1. Help your child manage homework time.
2. Show interest in your child's studies by talking with him daily about what he's learning and doing in school.
3. Discuss ideas and feelings about school, studies, and activities.
4. Read and review with your child the information that schools and districts provide.
5. Contact counselors, administrators, and teachers periodically.
6. Be sure that he attends school on a regular basis.
7. Encourage her to pursue interests and make friends through extracurricular activities.
8. Know your child's friends. Who does your child hang out with?
9. Make it clear that she must follow school rules and policies.
10. Encourage him to get to know his counselor and to maintain contact throughout his middle-school years, if possible.
