In accordance with NYS Education Department/Department of Health guidelines

Opening of school directive will be issued by the Governor of New York

Townsend Elementary School

Grades UPK-5: In-person instruction daily

Socially distanced classrooms; utilizing alternative spaces (library, cafeteria, art room etc.) to accommodate all students in the building every day.

George F. Mack Middle School

Grades 6-8: Hybrid model

Two cohorts (Monday/Thursday and Tuesday/Friday).

Students in remote will be attending all classes on their schedule virtually.

Wednesday is individual remote learning; tasks assigned by teachers.

O'Neill High School

Grades 9-12: Hybrid model

Grades 9 and 11 will attend Monday/Tuesday; Grades 10 and 12 will attend Thursday/Friday. Students will attend classes based on their master schedules.

Students in remote will be attending all classes on their schedule virtually.

Wednesday is individual remote learning; tasks assigned by teachers.

8:1:1 and 12:1:1 classes

In-person daily (district-wide).

DCMO BOCES and out-of-district placements

Will attend in accordance with the schedule provided by BOCES and other placements. More information to follow.
