

## **School Budget Vote & Board Election**

The Walton Central School District 2020-2021 Budget Vote and Board of Education Election will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020.

### **Annual Budget Hearing**

The Annual Budget Hearing meeting will take place online via Walton CSD's YouTube account at 6 pm May 26, 2020. The public is welcome to view the meeting, please watch Walton's website for specific viewing information.

### **Who Can Vote**

You are an eligible voter if are:

- A legal US resident
- 18 years old by June 9, 2020
- Live within the Walton Central School District boundaries for at least 30 days prior to June 9, 2020
- Not otherwise disqualified.

### **How You Can Vote**

In the interest of public safety due to the COVID-19 pandemic, voting this year will take place using absentee ballots only, per Governor Cuomo's Executive Order. Every eligible voter can receive an absentee ballot and a postage paid return envelope in the mail.

Qualified voters on the poll lists for one or more of the last four school district votes and all voters in the school district who are registered with the Delaware County Board of Elections will be automatically sent an absentee ballot. Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter," but does not believe he/she will be on the School District's poll lists or does not receive a ballot by May 29, 2020, please contact Ms. Corey Phraner, District Clerk, at [cphraner@waltoncsd.org](mailto:cphraner@waltoncsd.org) as soon as possible to ensure timely receipt of an absentee ballot.
